Tree cutting agreement: I understand and agree that all tree cutting must be pre-approved by the Caretaker/Manager and/or Board of Directors. Trees may be taken for use to benefit SRW , may be used by the site manager or may be allowed to be used as wood for campfires. I understand that no firewood may be removed from the campground without prior permission from the Board of Directors. I understand that I am responsible for the removal of my personal property(RV's, tarps, tables, lighting, decorations, etc..) from the campsite during tree removal. If I do not remove my property and damage occurs I understand that I am responsible for all damage and replacement costs and I do not hold Skagit River Woods Camping Club liable. I also agree to clean up any limbs and debris caused by the cutting of any trees on my campsite and that cleanup will be done in a timely manner. I understand that the Caretaker/Manager may impose certain restrictions or make certain requests as needed to protect the interests of SRW and other members.
